HB 1529 -- VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER DEDUCTION

SPONSOR: Davis

Beginning January 1, 2019, this bill authorizes a \$500 income tax deduction for a volunteer firefighter who completes, during the year, at least 12 hours of any firefighter training program approved by the Office of the State Fire Marshal within the Department of Public Safety. If a firefighter completes at least 36 hours of training by completing the Basic Fire Fighter Program or being certified after completing the division's Fire Fighter I or Fire Fighter II Program, the firefighter may claim a \$1,000 deduction.

The provisions of the bill will expire December 31 six years after the effective date.

This bill is the same as HB 787 (2017).
