HCS HB 1574 -- COLLABORATIVE PRACTICE ARRANGEMENTS (Rowland (155))

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Professional Registration and Licensing

This bill allows a physician to enter into collaborative practice arrangements or supervision agreements with a total of six fulltime equivalent advanced practice registered nurses (APRN), assistant physicians, or physician assistants, in any combination thereof. Currently, a doctor can work with up to three APRNs and three physician assistants at a time.

This bill is the similar to HB 244 (2017).
