HCS HB 1576 -- ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

SPONSOR: Wiemann

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Standing Committee on Government Efficiency by a vote of 7 to 0.

This bill requires all regulations of any type to be explicitly permitted or required by statute prior to being promulgated under Chapter 536, RSMo.

If a fiscal note estimate for a proposed rule under Chapter 536 is greater than \$500,000 in the aggregate with regard to either regulatory expenditures or estimated reductions in income, then the rule is disallowed unless approved by the General Assembly via concurrent resolution.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that administrative regulations are litigated too much and the bill will just add a speed bump to slow the process down.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Wiemann; Missouri Land Title Association; Missouri Insurance Coalition; Missouri Limestone Association; National Federation of Independent Business; Missouri Retailers Association; Missouri Grocers Association; and Associated Industries of Missouri.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
