HB 1768 -- CONCEALED CARRY OF FIREARMS

SPONSOR: Moon

This bill removes the current criminal penalty for carrying a concealed firearm, without a concealed carry permit, into any location where concealed carry is prohibited in Section 571.107, RSMo. Instead, an individual carrying a concealed firearm can be subject to denial to or removal from the premises; if he or she refuses to leave the premises and a peace officer is summoned the individual may be issued a citation for an amount not to exceed \$100 for the first offense, with an increased fine for subsequent violations.

This bill is the same as HB 1107 (2017).
