

HB 1800 -- PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

SPONSOR: Miller

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Utilities by a vote of 13 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Rules-Administrative Oversight Committee by a vote of 14 to 0.

This bill states that the Missouri Public Service Commission has the power to make and entertain complaints involving laws subject to the commission's authority, rules promulgated by the commission, or any utility tariff, order, or decision of the commission.

This bill is similar to HB 1077 (2017).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill narrowly tailors the commission's complaint process such that the commission will only need to process complaints that it has the authority to hear.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Miller and Shelley Brueggemann, Missouri Public Service Commission.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
