

HB 1838 -- CONVEYANCE OF STATE PROPERTY

SPONSOR: Bernskoetter

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Corrections and Public Institutions by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass- Not Consent" by the Consent and House Procedure Committee by a vote of 12 to 0.

This bill authorizes and empowers the Governor to convey all interest in specific property, described in the bill, located in Jefferson City, Missouri. The Commissioner of Administration shall set the terms and conditions for the conveyance as he or she deems reasonable.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that they have already raised money from private sources to create safe and appealing access to the river, especially to the thousands of kids who visit the Capitol every year.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Bernskoetter and James Crabtree.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
