HB 1874 -- PRODUCTS SOLD IN STATE CAPITOL

SPONSOR: Taylor

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Small Business by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Rules-Administrative Oversight Committee by a vote of 13 to 0.

This bill requires that any non-food product sold in the Missouri State Capitol Building be made in the United States.

This bill is similar to HB 686 (2017).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will promote economic development in the state and country.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Taylor.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.

OTHERS: Others testifying on the bill say that it will coordinate well with the Buy Missouri Initiative.
