

HB 1898 -- CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE ABUSE FUND

SPONSOR: Swan

This bill creates a Controlled Substance Abuse Prevention Fund within the state treasury that is funded by moneys appropriated by the General Assembly, not to exceed the amount collected by the Department of Health and Senior Services when issuing registrations to manufacture, distribute, or dispense controlled substances. Any money in the fund must be used solely for the operation, regulation, enforcement, and educational activities of the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs.

This bill is similar to HB 103 (2017).
