

HB 1967 -- STATE PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATION

SPONSOR: Trent

This bill repeals certain provisions of the merit-based State Personnel Law. The provisions providing for the appointment or promotion to a position on the basis of merit, and demotions and dismissals made for cause, are repealed. The Personnel Advisory Board is eliminated and multiple provisions of law referring to the board and its administrative procedures are repealed. The bill requires the Governor, by executive order, to promulgate rules relating to personnel administration in the executive agencies of the state, including the appointment and dismissal of state employees.

The effective date of this bill is July 1, 2019.
