HB 1987 -- STATUTES OF LIMITATION

SPONSOR: Ellington

This bill specifies that there is no statute of limitation on any action for damages for personal injury caused to an individual by a person related to them within the third degree by blood or marriage who subjects the individual to sexual contact. Currently, there is a 10-year statute of limitation on this cause of action.

Currently, prosecutions for unlawful sexual offenses involving a person 18 years of age or under must be commenced within 30 years after the victim reaches the age of 18. This bill specifies that such prosecutions or any prosecution for child abuse may be commenced at any time.

This bill is the same as HB 519 (2017).
