HB 2037 -- CONGRESSIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR PLATES

SPONSOR: Davis

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Veterans by a vote of $11\ \text{to}\ 0$.

This bill specifies that an applicant will pay no additional fee to the regular registration fee for the Congressional Medal of Honor license plates.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the Department of Revenue does not charge the specialty license plate fees for other military plates and Medal of Honor recipients have been recognized for their extraordinary efforts protecting our country and should not be charged additional fees.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Davis; Department of Revenue; Dewey M. Riehn, Missouri Alliance of Veterans Organizations; and VFW.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
