

HB 2039 -- ROUTE 66 CENTENNIAL COMMISSION (Fraker)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Special Committee on Tourism

This bill creates the Missouri Route 66 Centennial Commission composed of 18 members who reflect the interests, history and importance of the communities along Route 66 in Missouri. Of the 18 members, the commission includes two members appointed by the Speaker and two members appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives. The duties of the commission are to plan and sponsor official Route 66 centennial events, programs and activities, to encourage the development of programs designed to involve citizens in commemorative activities and events, and to make available public information about commemorative events happening throughout the state. Before June 30, 2027, a final report on the commission's activities must be delivered to the Governor and the commission will dissolve on that date.
