

HB 2067 -- MISSOURI WHISKEY

SPONSOR: Cornejo

This bill requires that any intoxicating liquor advertised, described, labeled, named, sold, or referred to for marketing and sales purposes as Missouri whiskey, Missouri bourbon, or Missouri bourbon whiskey must meet the following standards: the intoxicating liquor must have been manufactured in the State of Missouri; made with a grain mixture that is at least 51% Missouri-grown corn and unfiltered, untreated Missouri water; aged in new, charred Missouri oak barrels, in the State of Missouri; distilled to no more than 160 proof or 80% alcohol by volume; and bottled at no less than 80% proof or 40% alcohol by volume.
