HB 2132 -- INVESTIGATIONS OF OFFICER-INVOLVED INCIDENTS

SPONSOR: Butler

This bill requires the Attorney General to appoint a special prosecutor to conduct an investigation and determine if charges against the officer or officers are appropriate whenever an officer-involved death occurs or an incident where severe officer misconduct is alleged and likely occurred.

The bill also specifies the Attorney General's authority to appoint a special prosecutor, as well as what powers the appointed special prosecutor shall have and what he or she may be paid for serving as a special prosecutor.
