HB 2142 -- TAX AND FEE INCREASE ELECTION DAYS

SPONSOR: Marshall

This bill specifies that any issue to increase any tax, license, fee, or levy in any political subdivision that is required to be approved by the voters under Article X, Sections 16 to 24 of the Missouri Constitution, commonly known as the Hancock Amendment, must be placed on the ballot only on the general election day, which is the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even-numbered years as designated under Section 115.121.1, RSMo.

This bill is the same as HB 798 (2017).
