HB 2164 -- CHILDREN EXPOSED TO CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

SPONSOR: Rehder

Currently, a health care provider may refer a family to the Department of Health and Senior Services when a child may have been exposed to a controlled substance and the department is required to offer service coordination services, upon referral, to the family. This bill changes the department to the Children's Division within the Department of Social Services and removes the requirement that the department offer coordination services to the family.
