HB 2211 -- MEETING NOTICE

SPONSOR: Kidd

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Government Efficiency by a vote of 8 to 1. Voted "Do Pass" by the Rules- Legislative Oversight Committee by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill requires committees, boards, task forces, councils, commissions, and other types of state entities to provide notice of meetings and whether or not the meetings are open to the public under the Sunshine Law, to the Office of Administration no later than 24 hours prior to a meeting. The information must be posted in a searchable format on the Missouri accountability portal.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the public has a right to access this information.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Kidd.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
