HB 2268 -- TRANSPORTATION REPORTING

SPONSOR: Reiboldt

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 9 to 0.

This bill removes the Section 21.795, RSMo, requirements involving details for financial reports submitted by the Department of Transportation to the Joint Committee on Transportation Oversight. In lieu of extremely lengthy and detailed mandated reporting, three annually produced publications from the department will be provided to the committee.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the bill will greatly reduce paperwork and save almost \$35,000 in expenses annually. The data contained in the current report will be available to the committee if needed and much of it is available on the department's website.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Reiboldt and the Missouri Department of Transportation.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
