

HB 2335 -- PUBLIC SCHOOL RETIREMENT SYSTEM

SPONSOR: Black

This bill allows any teacher retired from the Public School Retirement System of Missouri to be employed in a position covered under the Public Education Employee Retirement System (PEERS) without stopping their retirement benefit. Such teacher may earn up to 50% of the minimum teacher's salary as set forth in Section 163.172, RSMo and will not contribute to the retirement system or earn creditable service.

The employer's contribution rate will be paid by the hiring employer. If such person is employed in excess of these limitations, the person will not be eligible to receive their retirement allowance for any month the person is employed and such person shall contribute to the retirement system if he or she is in an eligible position.
