HCS HB 2353 -- STATE EMPLOYEE PAY

SPONSOR: May

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass with HCS" by the Special Committee on Employment Security by a vote of 9 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee by Rules- Administrative Oversight by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill requires that the pay period for all state employees shall not exceed 14 days unless otherwise provided for under law.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will encourage people to enter state employment by ensuring more frequent pay periods.

Testifying for the bill was Representative May.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
