HB 2366 -- DEATH RECORDS

SPONSOR: Beard

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Judiciary by a vote of 9 to 0.

Currently, a listing of persons who are born or who die on a particular date may be disclosed upon request. This bill changes the law to require that a listing of persons who die on a particular date must be disclosed upon request.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that, currently, the Bureau of Vital Records has discretion whether to disclose certain information, and this bill requires the disclosure of that information.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Beard.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
