

HB 2388 -- FERTILITY PRESERVATION PROCEDURES FOR INSUREDS WITH A
CANCER DIAGNOSIS

SPONSOR: Neely

This bill requires insurance companies to cover fertility preservation procedures for insureds who are at least 18 years old and are diagnosed with cancer but have not started cancer treatment. Coverage shall include embryo, oocyte, and sperm cryopreservation procedures.

Any entity or individual who state in writing that methods of embryo, oocyte, and sperm cryopreservation procedures are contrary to such entity or individual's moral, ethical, or religious beliefs carrier may issued a policy or rider thereto that excludes coverage for such methods.
