HB 2467 -- HOME SCHOOL EDUCATION

SPONSOR: Kelly (141)

This bill changes the laws governing home school education. Currently, the parent must offer at least 1000 hours of instruction and maintain records of the child's academic work and progress. This bill permits a parent to comply with either of those requirements instead of both.

The bill also prohibits the local prosecuting attorney from reviewing home school records without reasonable suspicion of a violation of law.

A public school must keep confidential any individually identifiable information about children receiving home school education and parents of such children.

The bill also repeals provisions regarding parents providing notice that their children will attend home school.
