HB 2469 -- BOARDING OF PRISONERS

SPONSOR: Peters

This bill repeals a provision relating to how much county jails or other institutions shall be reimbursed for detention of prisoners. Additionally, the bill specifies that a jail or other institution may refuse to detain an offender if funds are not available to provide detention.

The bill repeals provisions related to how the cost per diem for jail reimbursement is calculated and specifies that the state shall provide payment to counties on a quarterly basis, and it specifies how payment shall be calculated.

The bill has an effective date of January 1, 2019.
