HB 2608 -- SEXUAL OFFENDER REGISTRY

SPONSOR: Morgan

This bill adds provisions that allow an individual on the sex offender registry who does not meet the requirements to file a removal petition to file a petition in the division of the circuit court in the county or city not within a county in which the offense requiring registration was adjudicated or, if it was adjudicated outside Missouri, in the division of the circuit court in the county or city not within a county in which such person resides, to have his or her name and information removed from the sexual offender registry as long as 20 years have passed since the date of the conviction for such sex offense. The bill specifies what information the petition must include.

This bill is similar to HB 1117 (2017).
