HB 2681 -- FEDERAL REAL ID ACT COMPLIANCE

SPONSOR: Corlew

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Veterans by a vote of 12 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Rules-Legislative Oversight Committee by a vote of 8 to 2.

This bill clarifies that the biometric data, digital images, source documents, and licensee signatures required to be collected or retrained to comply with the requirements of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005 shall be digitally retained for no longer than the minimum duration required.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill clarifies which documents are to be retained on the server that is for Real ID documents and the retention length of certain documents.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Corlew; Missouri Department of Revenue; Missouri Chamber of Commerce and Industry; and the Greater Kansas City Chamber of Commerce.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
