HJR 51 -- TERM LIMITS FOR STATEWIDE ELECTED OFFICIALS

SPONSOR: Plocher

Upon voter approval, this Constitutional amendment imposes a uniform term limit of two terms of four years each on all statewide elected officials. Term limits imposed for the first time on the offices of State Auditor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, and Lieutenant Governor shall apply prospectively to anyone elected during the general election of 2020 or thereafter or, in the case of the State Auditor's office, the election held in 2022 or thereafter.
