HJR 88 -- LABOR ORGANIZATIONS

SPONSOR: McDaniel

Upon voter approval, this proposed Constitutional amendment prohibits employers from requiring employees to join or refrain from joining a labor organization, or requiring employees to pay any dues to a labor organization. Any agreement between an employer and a labor organization contrary to this provision is void. Certain specified employers, employees, and agreements are excluded from the provisions of this proposed Constitutional amendment.

This bill is the same as HJR 15 (2017).
