HJR 99 -- REAPPORTIONMENT OF SENATE AND HOUSE DISTRICTS

SPONSOR: Plocher

Upon voter approval, this proposed Constitutional amendment modifies the criteria for reapportionment of state Senate and House of Representatives districts. In its main provisions, the amendment requires:

(1) The use of United States citizens for purposes of the population used in reapportionment;

(2) That all districts be contiguous in territory with no exceptions; and

(3) Districts to be as compact as possible after accounting for county and city lines and geographic boundaries.

This bill is similar to HJR 100 (2018).
