

HJR 103 -- LABOR ORGANIZATIONS

SPONSOR: Vescovo

Upon voter approval, this proposed Constitutional amendment prohibits employers from requiring employees to join or refrain from joining a labor organization, or requiring employees to pay any dues to a labor organization. A person injured by a violation of this section may recover damages including reasonable attorney's fees. Prosecuting attorneys, circuit attorneys, and the Attorney General are charged with investigating complaints under this amendment. Any agreement between an employer and a labor organization contrary to this provision is void. Certain specified employers, employees, and agreements are excluded from the provisions of this proposed Constitutional amendment.

This bill is the similar to HJR 79, HJR 88, SJR 40 (2018) and HJR 15 (2017).
