1 AMEND House Bill No. 114, Page 2, Section 589.414, Lines 31-34, by deleting said lines and
2 inserting in lieu there of the following:

4 "subdivision, shall also be required to deposit his or her driver's license with the chief law
5 enforcement official with whom the person last registered. If the person registers with the chief law
6 enforcement official having jurisdiction over the new residence or address and the official verifies
7 the new residence or address, the license shall be returned. If the person fails to register within three
8 business days with the chief law enforcement official having jurisdiction over the new residence or
9 address, the person shall be guilty of the offense of failure to register, under section 589.425, and a
10 warrant for the person's arrest shall be issued, the person's driver's license shall be suspended, and
11 the person shall be required to be electronically monitored for a period of two years regardless of
12 whether the person is sentenced to a term of imprisonment. The person shall be responsible for all
13 costs associated with electronic monitoring."; and

15 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
16 accordingly.
