1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 427, Page 7, Section 479.360, Line 31, by  
2 inserting after said section and line the following:

4 "590.1100. 1. The department of public safety or the department of transportation may  
5 engage in discussions with local government officials or law enforcement agencies to develop a  
6 memorandum of understanding concerning the use of automated license plate reader systems and  
7 crime cameras by law enforcement on public roadways within the state. The memorandum of  
8 understanding shall contain detailed policies and protocols regarding the use of automated license  
9 plate reader systems and crime cameras, including specific policies on data retention.

10 2. As used in this section, "automated license plate reader system", means a system of one  
11 or more mobile or fixed high-speed cameras combined with computer algorithms to convert images  
12 of registration plates into computer-readable data.

13 3. Prior to August 28, 2020, the department of public safety shall promulgate, by rule, a  
14 standard for the installation of fixed automated license plate reader systems by government entities.  
15 The rule shall be posted on the department's official website.

16 4. The department of public safety shall promulgate all necessary rules and regulations for  
17 the administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section  
18 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it  
19 complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section  
20 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the  
21 general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and  
22 annual a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any  
23 rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2019, shall be invalid and void."; and

25 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
26 accordingly.
