- (b) If the application fails to meet the requirements of sections 160.400 to 160.425 and section 167.349, the state board of education shall deny the charter in writing, identify the specific failures of the application to meet the requirements of sections 160.400 to 160.425 and section 167.349 in the written denial, and provide the written denial within ten business days to the sponsor.
- (c) If the application meets the requirements of sections 160.400 to 160.425 and section 167.349, the state board of education shall direct the board of directors of the school district in which the charter school is proposed to be located to cause the question of charter approval to be submitted to the voters of the district at the next municipal election or, if the next annual school election is more than sixty days away, cause the question to be submitted to the voters in the district at a special election called in accordance with law on a date set by the state board of education. The election shall be conducted in the manner provided by law for the conducting of school district elections generally. A majority affirmative vote for approval is required for approval of the charter school application."; and
