"160.440. 1. For purposes of this section, "magnet school" means a school with specialized
curricula that draws its student body from geographic areas outside the attendance zone of such
school but within the attendance zone of the school district in which such school is located.
2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a school district may convert any school
within its district into a magnet school. Any student who lives within the attendance zone of the
school district may attend such magnet school, subject to the provisions of subsection 3 of this
section.
3. If capacity is insufficient to enroll qualified students who seek admission to the magnet
school, the magnet school shall have an admissions process that ensures that all students who seek
admission have an equal chance of gaining admission; except that, the magnet school may give a
preference for admission of students who submit an application for admission before a certain date.
4. A school district shall not be required to provide transportation to any student attending a
magnet school who lives outside the attendance zone of such school but within the attendance zone
of the school district.
5. This section shall not apply to any magnet school that was operating before the effective
date of this section."; and
