1 AMEND House Bill No. 445, Page 9, Section 105.473, Line 132, by inserting after all of said
2 section and line the following:

4 "Section 1. 1. Beginning January 1, 2020, any political subdivision or state agency shall
5 provide an annual report to the Missouri ethics commission that lists total annual aggregate
6 spending per lobbyist and annual total aggregate spending on lobbying activities. The first report
7 shall be due no later than February 1, 2021, and shall encompass the prior year's expenditures for its
8 content.

9 2.The ethics commission may specify by rule that the reports be made in an electronic
10 format and delivered to the commission by electronic means. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that
11 term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall
12 become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if
13 applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the
14 powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective
15 date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of
16 rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2019, shall be invalid and
17 void.

18 3. A violation of this section shall be punishable as allowed under section 105.478 and is
19 subject to the jurisdiction of the ethics commission under section 105.472."; and

21 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
22 accordingly.
