AMEND House Amendment No. \_\_\_\_ to House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 420,  
Page 1, Line 6, by inserting after the number "188.125" the following:

" . This extension in the geographic boundaries of collaborative practice agreements shall only apply if the assistant physician provides clients with medically accurate information, which for the purposes of this subsection means information that is:

(i) Verified or supported by the weight of medical research;

(ii) Conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods;

(iii) Recognized as correct and objective by leading medical organizations with relevant expertise or government agencies, such as the: American Medical Association; American Congress of Obstetricians and Gynecologists; American Public Health Association; American Academy of Pediatrics; American College of Physicians; American Academy of Family Physicians; Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; Food and Drug Administration; National Cancer Institute; American Psychological Association; National Institute for Health; or

(iv) Recommended by or affirmed in the medical practice guidelines of a nationally recognized accrediting organization, such as the: Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO); National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA); American Accreditation HealthCare Commission; Utilization Review Accreditation Commission (AAHC/URAC); or Accreditation Association for Ambulatory HealthCare (AAAHHC);

This does not apply to or prohibit religious speech; it is limited to discussions of medical information within an alternatives to abortion agency"; and

Further amend said amendment and page, Line 13, by inserting after the number "188.125" the following:

" . This extension in the geographic boundaries of collaborative practice agreements shall only apply if the advanced practice registered nurse provides clients with medically accurate information, which for the purposes of this subsection means information that is:

(i) Verified or supported by the weight of medical research;

(ii) Conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods;

(iii) Recognized as correct and objective by leading medical organizations with relevant expertise or government agencies, such as the: American Medical Association; American Congress
