1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for  
2 Senate Bill No. 291, Page 23, Section 488.5050, Line 21, by inserting after all of said line the  
3 following:  
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5 "590.120. 1. There is hereby established within the department of public safety a "Peace  
6 Officer Standards and Training Commission" which shall be composed of eleven members,  
7 including a voting public member, appointed by the governor, by and with the advice and consent of  
8 the senate, from ~~[a list]~~ lists of qualified candidates submitted to the governor by the director of the  
9 department of public safety, the Missouri Police Chiefs Association, and the Missouri Sheriffs'  
10 association. No more than two members of the POST commission shall reside in the same  
11 congressional district as any other at the time of their appointments but this provision shall not apply  
12 to the public member. Three members of the POST commission shall be sitting police chiefs~~[-]~~ and  
13 three members shall be sitting sheriffs, one member shall represent a state law enforcement agency  
14 covered by the provisions of this chapter, ~~[two members]~~ one member shall be a peace [officers]  
15 officer at or below the rank of sergeant employed by a [political subdivision] municipality, one  
16 member shall be a peace officer at or below the rank of sergeant employed by a county, and one  
17 member shall be a chief executive officer of a certified training academy. The public member shall  
18 be at the time of appointment a registered voter; a person who is not and never has been a member  
19 of any profession certified or regulated under this chapter or the spouse of such person; and a person  
20 who does not have and never has had a material financial interest in either the providing of the  
21 professional services regulated by this chapter, or an activity or organization directly related to any  
22 profession certified or regulated under this chapter. Each member of the POST commission shall  
23 have been at the time of his appointment a citizen of the United States and a resident of this state for  
24 a period of at least one year, and members who are peace officers shall be qualified as established by  
25 this chapter. No member of the POST commission serving a full term of three years may be  
26 reappointed to the POST commission until at least one year after the expiration of his most recent  
27 term.

28 2. Three of the original members of the POST commission shall be appointed for terms of  
29 one year, three of the original members shall be appointed for terms of two years, and three of the  
30 original members shall be appointed for terms of three years. Thereafter the terms of the members  
31 of the POST commission shall be for three years or until their successors are appointed. The  
32 director may remove any member of the POST commission for misconduct or neglect of office.  
33 Any member of the POST commission may be removed for cause by the director but such member  
34 shall first be presented with a written statement of the reasons thereof, and shall have a hearing  
35 before the POST commission if the member so requests. Any vacancy in the membership of the  
36 commission shall be filled by appointment for the unexpired term. No two members of the POST

1 commission shall be employees of the same law enforcement agency.

2 3. Annually, the ~~[director]~~ POST commission members shall appoint one of the members as  
3 chairperson by majority vote of the POST commission members. The POST commission shall meet  
4 at least twice each year as determined by the director or a majority of the members to perform its  
5 duties. A majority of the members of the POST commission shall constitute a quorum.

6 4. No member of the POST commission shall receive any compensation for the performance  
7 of his official duties.

8 5. The POST commission shall guide and advise the director concerning duties pursuant to  
9 this chapter."; and
