With the approval of [his division director] the director of the department of 6 corrections, the chief administrative officer of any correctional center operated by the division may 7 establish and operate a canteen or commissary for the use and benefit of the offenders. 8 2. [Each correctional center shall keep revenues received from the canteen or commissary 9 established and operated by the correctional center in a separate account. The acquisition cost of 10 goods sold and other expenses shall be paid from this account.] The "Inmate Canteen Fund" is hereby established in the state treasury and shall consist of funds received from the operation of the 11 inmate canteens. A minimum amount of money necessary to meet cash flow needs and current 12 13 operating expenses may be kept in this [account] fund. The [remaining funds from sales of each commissary or canteen shall be deposited monthly in a special fund to be known as the "Inmate 14 Canteen Fund" which is hereby created and shall be expended by the appropriate division, for the 15 16 benefit of proceeds generated from the operation of the inmate canteens shall be expended solely 17 for any of the following, or combination thereof: the offenders in the improvement of recreational, religious, [or] educational services, or reentry services. All interest earned by the fund shall be 18 19 credited to the fund and shall be used solely for the purposes described in this section. The 20 provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary notwithstanding, [the] any money remaining in the inmate canteen fund at the end of the biennium shall be retained for the purposes specified in this 21 22 section and shall not revert to the credit of or be transferred to general revenue. [The department 23 shall keep accurate records of the source of money deposited in the inmate canteen fund and shall allocate appropriations from the fund to the appropriate correctional center.]"; and 24 25 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references 26

accordingly.
