12	(3) Community policing efforts derived from research-based models.
13	3. Distribution of state funds or technical assistance shall be by contractual arrangement
14	between the department and each recipient law enforcement agency. Terms of the contract shall be
15	negotiable each year. The state auditor shall periodically audit all law enforcement agencies
16	receiving state funds.
17	4. Nothing in this section shall prohibit any law enforcement agency from receiving federal
18	or local funds should such funds become available.
19	5. All law enforcement agencies, municipal and county, located in any county [of the first
20	classification with more than one hundred fifty thousand but fewer than two hundred thousand
21	inhabitants, any county of the first classification with more than eighty-three thousand but fewer
