4.] 3. Any person who gratuitously and in good faith renders emergency care by use of or
provision of an automated external defibrillator shall not be held liable for any civil damages or
subject to a criminal penalty as a result of such care or treatment, unless the person acts in a willful
and wanton or reckless manner in providing the care, advice, or assistance. The person or entity
who provides [appropriate] training to the person using an automated external defibrillator, the
person or entity responsible for the site where the automated external defibrillator is located, and the
person or entity that owns the automated external defibrillator, the person or entity that provided
clinical protocol for automated external defibrillator sites or programs, and the licensed physician
who reviews and approves the clinical protocol shall likewise not be held liable for civil damages
or subject to a criminal penalty resulting from the use of an automated external defibrillator.
