1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 604, Page 9, Section 161.1130, Line 10,  
2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

4 "168.300. 1. Every school district in this state including special school districts may adopt  
5 policies and regulations providing for deductions from the compensation of the district's employees  
6 whenever a request to do so is presented to the board by a group of ten or more employees.

7 2. Deductions shall be made from compensation earned by the employee and shall be  
8 remitted to the appropriate company, association, or organization as authorized by the employee  
9 within fifteen days following the deduction.

10 3. Deductions may be made for, but not limited to, the following: credit unions, tax  
11 sheltered annuities, individual retirement accounts, [~~membership dues,~~] voluntary contributions, or  
12 group insurance premiums.

13 4. A board of education when deducting amounts from the compensation of employees as  
14 directed by the employee shall not be liable for any good faith error.

15 5. The school board shall determine the cost of compliance with this section and shall  
16 deduct, in addition to the amount to be paid to any entity for which deduction is authorized, the cost  
17 of compliance with the request of the employee.

18 6. The various subsections of this section shall be deemed severable and if a subsection of  
19 this section is declared invalid or unconstitutional, then such declaration shall not affect the  
20 remaining subsections.

21 Section 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, no public school district shall directly or  
22 indirectly pay membership dues on behalf of a district employee to any group, association, or other  
23 organization that employs or contracts with a registered lobbyist."; and

25 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
26 accordingly.
