1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 358, Page 1, Section A, Line 3, by inserting after said section and line the  
2 following:

4 "188.345. 1. For purposes of this section, the term "medically accurate information" shall  
5 mean information that is:

6 (1) Verified or supported by the weight of medical research;

7 (2) Conducted in compliance with accepted scientific methods;

8 (3) Recognized as correct and objective by leading medical organizations with relevant  
9 expertise or government agencies, such as the: American Medical Association; American Congress  
10 of Obstetricians and Gynecologists; American Public Health Association; American Academy of  
11 Pediatrics; American College of Physicians; American Academy of Family Physicians; Centers for  
12 Disease Control and Prevention; Food and Drug Administration; National Cancer Institute;  
13 American Psychological Association; National Institute for Health; or

14 (4) Recommended by or affirmed in the medical practice guidelines of a nationally  
15 recognized accrediting organization, such as the: Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare  
16 Organizations (JCAHO); National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA); American  
17 Accreditation HealthCare Commission; Utilization Review Accreditation Commission  
18 (AAHC/URAC); or Accreditation Association for Ambulatory HealthCare (AAAHHC).

19 2. To be eligible for state funds, all organizations that provide pregnancy-related services or  
20 counseling, including those that provide services or counseling under the alternatives to abortion  
21 services program described in section 188.325, shall provide program participants with medically  
22 accurate and unbiased information on all relevant reproductive health options, including, but not  
23 limited to, information about family planning, birth control, pregnancy, abortion, adoption, labor and  
24 delivery, and postpartum care.

25 3. Any organization that provides pregnancy-related services or counseling, including an  
26 organization that provides services or counseling under the alternatives to abortion services  
27 program, that violates the provisions of this section shall not be eligible to receive any state funding  
28 or tax incentives including, but not limited to, temporary assistance for needy families funds or tax  
29 credits."; and

31 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
32 accordingly.
