21	"Redistricting Public Comment Portal", for the purpose of allowing the public acceptance of
22	comments, records, documents, maps, data files, communication, or information of any kind relating
23	to the redistricting process.
24	2. The commission shall accept public comments, records, documents, maps, data files,
25	communication, and information of any kind relating to the redistricting process solely through the
26	redistricting public comment portal.
