1 AMEND House Committee Bill No. 3, Page 2, Section 9.169, Line 6, by inserting after said section
2 and line the following:

4 "9.170. The third week of September shall be known as "Historically Black College and
5 University Week". The citizens of this state are encouraged to observe the week with appropriate
6 events and activities recognizing the importance of historically black colleges and universities,
7 especially Lincoln University and Harris-Stowe State University, the two historically black colleges
8 and universities located in Missouri."; and

10 Further amend said bill and page, Section 9.240, Line 4, by inserting after said section and line the
11 following:

13 "9.245. The month of May is hereby designated as "Lupus Awareness Month" and May
14 tenth of each year is designated "Lupus Awareness Day" in Missouri. Citizens of this state are
15 encouraged to recognize the month by wearing purple and with appropriate events and activities to
16 raise awareness about lupus, an autoimmune disease without a cure that is difficult to diagnose and
17 treat."; and

19 Further amend said bill, Page 3, Section 9.285, Line 5, by inserting after said section and line the
20 following:

22 "9.286. The month of October shall be known and designated as "Eczema Awareness
23 Month". The citizens of this state are encouraged to participate in appropriate activities and events
24 to increase awareness of this chronic, inflammatory skin disease.

25 9.287. The first full week of February each year shall be known and designated as "Missouri
26 School Counseling Week". The citizens of this state are encouraged to participate in appropriate
27 activities and events to recognize and promote awareness of the importance of public and private
28 school counselors.

29 9.288. The first Tuesday after the first Monday in the month of November of every year
30 shall be known and designated as "Election Day". The citizens of this state are encouraged to
31 exercise their right to vote in the general election.

32 9.291. November thirteenth of each year shall be known and designated as "John Jordan
33 "Buck" O'Neil Day" in Missouri in honor of John Jordan "Buck" O'Neil, the first African American
34 who coached in Major League Baseball. He also played a major role in establishing the Negro
35 Leagues Baseball Museum in Kansas City, Missouri. It is recommended to the people of the state
36 that the day be appropriately observed through activities and events designed to celebrate the life of

2 9.292. The fourth Saturday in July each year shall be designated as "National Day of
3 the Cowboy" in Missouri. The citizens of this state are encouraged to participate in appropriate
4 activities and events to recognize the history and importance of the cowboy in the history of
5 Missouri and the nation."; and

7 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
8 accordingly.
