### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State** and **Missouri Senate** both assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

In response to a previous version, officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **St. Louis County Board of Elections** assume if the proposal lengthens a ballot to two pages, this could have a fiscal impact of about \$100,000.

In response to a similar version, officials from the **Kansas City Election Board** assumed the fiscal impact would be roughly \$500 per election for increased cost associated with legal notices.

Officials from the **Platte County Board of Elections** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

**Oversight** assumes the inclusion of this phrase and information will potentially increase fiscal impact regarding ballot length and printing costs to local election authorities. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero to unknown cost on the fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local election authorities were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
