FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Office of the Governor (GOV)** assume the proposal would establish the Malcolm X Day Commission within the Office of the Governor. The nine-member commission would organize and coordinate activities and events to honor Malcolm X.

Commissioners would serve without compensation but would be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses. The Office of the Governor would provide administrative support and funding for the Commission, estimated to be up to \$52,891 annually. The fiscal impact is based upon the 2017 expenditures of the Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration Commission under the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations (DOLIR).

Oversight assumes cost will be similar to the 2017 expenditures of the Martin Luther King Jr. Celebration under DOLIR to the General Revenue Fund of up to \$52,891 annually.

Officials from the **Office of Administration (OA)** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the Office of Administration has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note for OA.
