FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations** and **State Auditor's Office** both assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations and State Auditor's Office have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary.

Oversight notes with parts of Section 287.615 being repealed, this allows for administrative law judges (ALJ) current salaries to be adjusted subject to appropriation. This in turn, could result in an increase or decrease cost to the state. Oversight assumes that the current ALJ salaries will remain the same. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.
