Bill Summary: This proposal requires the POST Commission to implement a system that gives members of the National Guard and active duty or reserve members of the Armed Forces credit for completing basic training when applying for a peace officer license and establishes a training program for individuals receiving credit under the system.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

§590.045 - Peace officer license

Oversight notes that the **Department of Public Safety - Office of the Director** has stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. The Peace Officer Standards & Training Program (POST) already has a process in place that allows Military Police Officers to test out for a peace officer license without having to go to a Missouri Police Academy.

Oversight notes that the **Department of Public Safety - National Guard and State Treasurer's Office** have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organizations.

Subsection 590.045.4 creates the "Military Police Program of Instruction Fund" that is to be used to administer this program. The fund shall consist of moneys appropriated by the General Assembly or gifted by any person or organization. **Oversight** will reflect the possibility that the General Assembly could appropriate moneys to this new fund from the General Revenue Fund. Oversight will further assume all appropriated moneys, if any, and gifts will be expended in the same year on either training for qualified members or for administrative expenses incurred by DPS.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** state many bills considered by the General Assembly include provisions allowing or requiring agencies to submit rules and regulations to implement the act. The SOS is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of normal activity resulting from each year's legislative session. The fiscal impact for this fiscal note to the SOS for Administrative Rules is less than \$5,000. The SOS recognizes that this is a small amount and does not expect that additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the office can sustain with the core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the cost of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the governor.

Oversight assumes the SOS could absorb the costs of printing and distributing regulations related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require the printing and distribution of regulations at substantial costs, the SOS could require additional resources.

ASSUMPTION (continued)

Officials from the **Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR)** state the legislation is not anticipated to cause a fiscal impact to JCAR beyond its current appropriation.

Oversight assumes JCAR will be able to administer any rules resulting from this proposal with existing resources.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill requires the Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Commission to establish a point conversion system to award basic training credit to reserve or active duty members of the Armed Forces or National Guard who complete military basic training hours, including advanced individual training at the United States Army Military Police School. The POST Commission's authority and duties regarding this system are specified in the bill.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
