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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Missouri Ethics Commission (MEC)** assume this proposal does not have a fiscal impact. It is assumed these restrictions would result in a minimal number of complaints; however, if this assumption is incorrect the Commission would require additional staff resources.

Officials from the **Office of the Governor**, **Missouri Senate**, **Office of the Secretary of State**, **Missouri House of Representatives**, **State Auditor's Office**, **Office of the State Treasurer**, and **Attorney General's Office** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Officials from the **City of Columbia**, **City of Kansas City**, and **Springfield Public Schools** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the Missouri Ethics Commission, Office of the Governor, Missouri Senate, Office of the Secretary of State, Missouri House of Representatives, State Auditor's Office, Office of the State Treasurer, Attorney General's Office, City of Columbia, Springfield Public Schools, and City of Kansas City have stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their organization. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

Officials from the Missouri Lieutenant Governor did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes that the Missouri Lieutenant Governor will not be directly affected by this proposal.

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Officials from the **Missouri Senate**, **Office of the Secretary of State**, **State Auditor's Office**, **Office of the State Treasurer**, **Attorney General's Office**, and **City of Columbia** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization.

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ASSUMPTION (continued)

Oversight assumes that none of the house amendments will have a direct fiscal impact to the state or local political subdivisions.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts and political subdivisions were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
