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FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** assume the proposal will result in no cost to the department.

Officials from the **Springfield Public Schools** and **Wellsville-Middletown R-1 School District** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a previous version, HB 281 (2019), officials from the **Francis Howell School District** assumed the proposal would have no negative fiscal impact on their organization.

In response to a previous version, HB 281 (2019), officials from the **Northeast Nodaway R-5 School District** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization.

Oversight notes that the responding organizations stated the proposal would not have a direct fiscal impact on their respective organizations. However, Oversight assumes school districts could possibly save on transportation costs if they are allowed to implement alternative instructions plans including virtual learning methods. Oversight will show a range of \$0 to an unknown savings to school districts.

Oversight received a limited number of responses from school districts related to the fiscal impact of this proposal. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best current information available. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek the necessary approval to publish a new fiscal note.

Oversight only reflects the responses that we have received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other school districts were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Beginning with the 2020-21 school year, this bill allows a district to use an alternative instruction plan approved by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education for up to 60 hours due to inclement weather, as specified in the bill.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
